





Kenmore Historical Society News

by Lillian Jolly

The other evening my husband and I were driving past Prentiss Park where some very young baseball teams were playing under the lights. I started remembering the area when my family moved to Kenmore back in 1947. It was a very dark country road.

Battles Avenue only had three houses in that section of the Prentiss allotment. We lived in the middle of the block and there were wetlands on each side of us with willows growing wild. The road was a typical country road that was often used as a lovers' lane. I really don't remember much about across the road, which was open land next to what was once the Battles farm, then the Orchard Tavern in 1937, and Innes Junior High in 1959 (now Innes CLC). The 1929 Akron Plate Book, Plate 23A, shows all that land had been owned by Milton H. Prentiss. Early City Directories show Kenmore Realty Company listed with his name.

Prentiss Park had four baseball fields. There was a field where the parking area is by Innes and another one east of it. One was where the parking is on Battles and another where the current one by expressway is today, but it had dirt banked around it then. In the winter it would be flooded and used for ice-skating. There was a wooded area where the basketball court is today. Youth football teams and cheerleaders would practice on the other side of the trees toward Battles and there was also some playground equipment there.

We had no sewers or city water until the late 50's or early 60's. More houses started springing up and we began living the "city" life!
