We have access at three places to the Towpath Trail:

- 2. Wilbeth Road—This is a new Trail Head with rest rooms, a drinking fountain and an information area.
- 3. Lewis Street (Just North of Kenmore Boulevard off Lakeshore) —There are no facilities here but it is convenient since it is right off the Boulevard.

Trail users can go North or South from all three locations.

North across the floating trail on Summit Lake is interesting and unusual. South along the canal is interesting for wild life. There are ducks, geese and occasional Blue Herons and deer.
