It's easy to apply.

Just contact our program's administrator, ARM BAYLOR at 888-235-8051, or e-mail them at bbaylor@baylorwc.com to begin the process. Tell them that you want to apply for the Akron Boards of Trade Council Workers' Compensation Program. If you are already participating in group rating through the ABOTC you need not make a new application.

There is no obligation to find out how much you can save.

If you have been rejected from, or are already participating in another program, by all means apply anyway. The evaluation doesn't interfere with your present arrangements. You may be pleasantly surprised at how much you can save through the program. When you are notified, you can say "Great! Sign me up!" or you can say "No thanks." There is no obligation or charge.
