Greetings to All!



The Kenmore Chamber of Commerce WANTS to help save you some money, really!

There are many benefits offered for our members to take advantage of, some more useful than others, I will admit, depending on your business. There are some real savings to be had here for your business, especially if you use natural gas for more than just heating your building & water (restaurants come to mind - please make note of the additional flyer mailed out with your newsletter). It doesn't cost anything to check and see if you too can have these savings, just call the offices of the **Community Energy Advisors** at 330-208-2082 and see how much you can save. You will not regret finding out that this benefit will work for you!
