There are over 2600 miniatures alone in my gaming section, and that is only one of the many categories of merchandise that have thousands of items to be counted and confirmed in my inventory system. Just as it is nice to know how much product (and therefore cost) I have in my store it is also good (but not nice) to see how much shrinkage I may have experienced in the preceding year (actually not much this past year).

And of course this year's problems involved that darn COVID pandemic we are still experiencing after almost two years. I usually have five employees helping with inventory (it takes a full day with this many), but this year I barely had two. One helper has been sick with COVID for over the past three weeks. One was quarantined at home with a daughter who caught COVID at school. And another was under quarantine when they found out several people at the Christmas day party they attended reported they had the virus later in the week, so this helper had to wait for a COVID test to come back to show whether they themselves were sick or not (fortunately the test was negative).

With the current surge going on now (is it the fifth, I lost count), I am still trying to be extra careful for the sake of myself and my family. I've had a mask request to enter my store since early Fall, and my customers understand my concern. I get more at-risk customers who appreciate being able to safely visit my store because of the mask rule versus the occasional one who doesn't (one girl called me a communist as she left because she would not wear a mask for the protection of others). I said "Thank you, have a safe day." There is no point in arguing.

We all have personal rules we live by, and we all take different amounts of risk while abiding or ignoring our own rules. I am lucky in that my customers & friends are the best, even when we disagree on some things we get along fine and respect each others desires and goals. The news media sometimes paints the world as different than this, but in this case I think they exaggerate for effect. I hope your world is like mine.
